#### What's been happening



DF4TA has set a target of raising £250,000 additional funding to ensure we are able to meet this increasing demand. This is what we doing to achieve this:

- We are looking for 1,000 people to donate £1 (a squid) a week, for the next 52 weeks.
- We are looking for 250-500 households who do not require £400 rebate from government to donate to us.
- In partnership with Derby Homes we aim to get 300 heated blankets, 180 slow cookers and 120 air fryers to help struggling residents of Derby.
- Community Action Derby together with Derby City Council launched a site dedicated to helping people who struggle with rising costs of living crisis: https://www.communityactionderby.org.uk/crisis-support/help-with-the-cost-of-living
- New Household Support Fund (phase 3) is now open and available until 31 March 2023, or until funding is fully used. We are actively encouraging agencies to refer.
- Spondon Community Care Hub launched in October. We are looking forward to working with them! We are now in partnership with 14 Derby food banks.

In September – October 2022 just over 4096 food parcels were directly distributed across all partners – LFDHs. For this period we helped 3801 children and 4403 adults. In past 2 months we had 25-30% increase in referrals.

Over £77K retail value of potential food waste items directly given to us by Costco have been redistributed April to November 2022.
