As part of Harvest Festival, we'd like to invite your school to take part in Food Bank Fortnight, a national two-week campaign, 1–14 October 2025.

For generations, Harvest Festival has been a time when schools and communities come together to give and share with those in need. And this tradition has never been more important. Today, 1 in 4 children are at risk of needing a food bank.

Led by the charity BanktheFood, Food Bank Fortnight offers a powerful way for your school community to get involved. Food banks can often receive too much of some items and not enough of others, making it harder for them to provide balanced parcels for families in need. By encouraging families to download the free BanktheFood app, they can connect with their local food bank and see in real-time what items are urgently needed.

This Schools Pack has been developed to support schools in delivering an impactful programme that addresses food poverty, community engagement, and smarter giving, especially during the harvest season.

Using our lively superhero characters and the free BanktheFood app, this programme educates students about the importance of giving the right help at the right time. It highlights how technology can be a force for good, empowering communities to act smarter and more compassionately.
